1) MONTHLY ACTIVITY REPORT: A detailed report is included with the Board packet regarding the following: North High Service Distribution Pump; Lead Service Line Inventory; Garden Villas Subdivision; Water Plant; Meter Installation; Water Usage & Water Loss; Water Sold Breakdown and Water Loss Chart.

<u>LSLI Questionnaire Discussion</u>: 1127 questionnaires were mailed the first week of June and to date 673 have been returned. That puts us at 60% currently.

## 2) WATER SALES/USAGE/LOSS REPORT:

The water loss for June was 17.4%.

- 3) NATIONAL LIEN SEARCH, LLC.: Company interested in the costs associated with reestablishing a previously forfeited meter. The Board discusses this issue and determines that information will only be given to the owners of the property, as shown on the deed.

**MOTION:** It is moved by Rick Reischman and seconded by Crystal Miles to raise the wholesale water rate by .25 (to \$7.05/1000 gallons) for January 1, 2025.
